The Bel-O-Mar Regional Council is proposing to revise the FY2010 – FY2013 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Fiscal Year programming is on a July 1 basis with FY2011 beginning July 1, 2010. Projects must be included in the local TIP and the State TIP to be eligible for federal funding. Bel-O-Mar is currently accepting public comments regarding the projects described below.

As requested by the West Virginia Department of Transportation, the following project would be added to the program.

- Installation of high friction surface treatment at several locations in District 6. Local routes include WV88 at milepost 2.71 and CR3 at milepost 0.68, both in Marshall County. The construction cost estimate is \$142,000 and the project would be programmed for FY2011.

As requested by the Belmont County Engineer, the following project would be added to the program.

- Repair of two historically significant bridges on the Old National Road. The first is located on CR40B at milepost 0.74 and the second on TR814 at milepost 0.21. The overall cost estimate is \$923,000. Engineering and design would be programmed for FY2011 and construction would be programmed for FY2013.

A public comment period regarding the proposed Transportation Improvement Program revision extends through October 27, 2010. Interested parties who desire to present their views on this proposed revision should submit written comments to:
