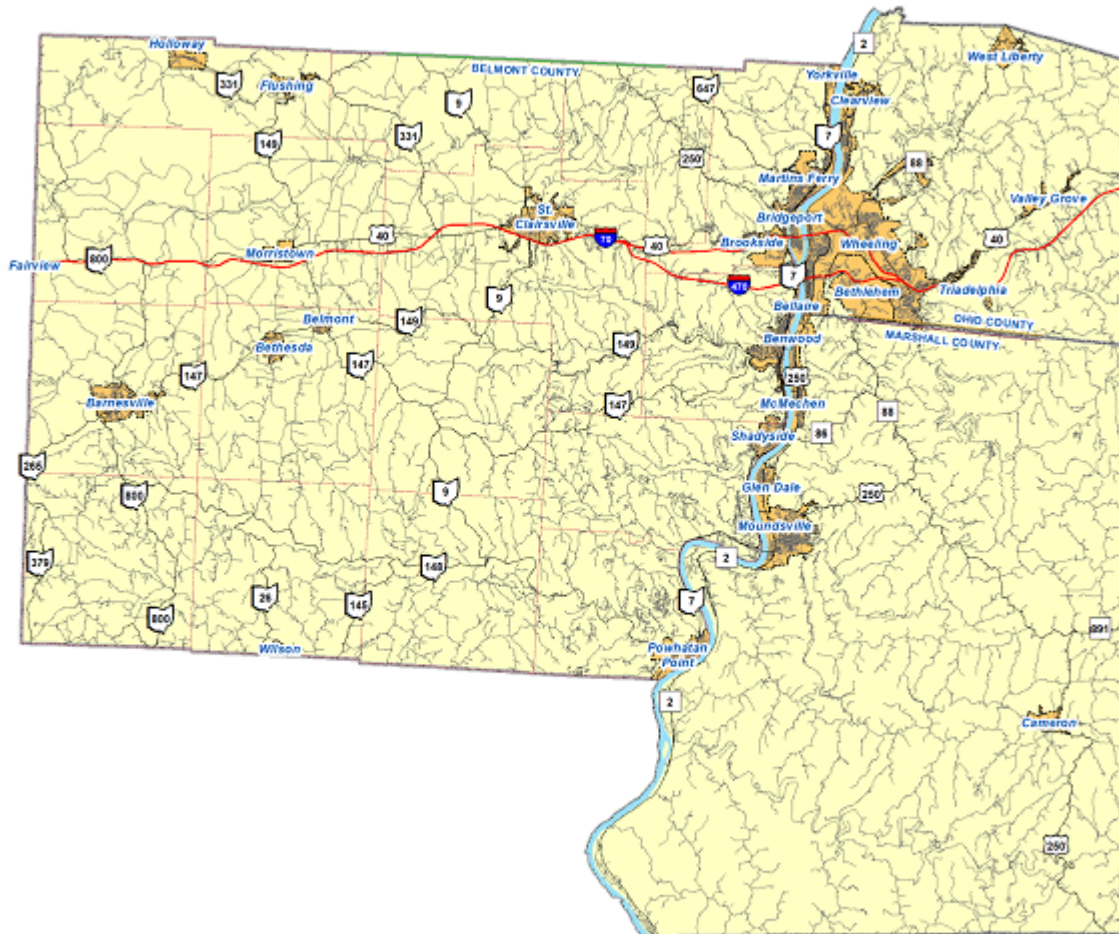
INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to federal regulations, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) are required to report annually on federal obligations during the preceding program year. Specifically, 23 CFR 450.334 requires:

- (a) In metropolitan planning areas, on an annual basis, no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year, the State, public transportation operator(s), and the MPO shall cooperatively develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation (facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year.

Belomar Regional Council and Interstate Planning Commission is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization for Belmont County in Ohio and Marshall and Ohio Counties in West Virginia. The MPO serves 27 local jurisdictions in the three county bi-state area. The metropolitan population is 139,513 and the combined land area is 948 square miles. A map of the region is shown below:

Belomar prepares a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that includes federally funded and regionally significant roadway and transit projects. The TIP is prepared on a July 1 - June 30 program year. The current TIP is for FY2021 - FY2024.

This report includes the list of federally funded projects for FY2022 based on the information provided by the West Virginia Department of Transportation (WVDOT), the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), and the Ohio Valley Regional Transportation Authority/Eastern Ohio Regional Transit Authority (OVRTA/EORTA).

Projects for which federal funds were obligated during this period may not have been completed or started as of June 30, 2022. However, federal action was taken for funding these projects. Additional maintenance projects completed using state funds are not included in this listing.

A public notice for the availability of this project list was placed in the local newspapers and on the agency website and Facebook page. The list was available on the agency website and in the office. The public notice is shown on page 6.
